The Camberley Town Centre Area Action Plan (AAP) will form part of the Local Development Framework for Surrey Heath and will set out policies for Camberley Town Centre up to 2026. The Area Action Plan will set out policies relating to: how Camberley Town Centre should evolve; the scale and location of new shopping facilities; leisure, cultural and community facilities; the level and location of housing and employment uses; improving transportation to and around the Town Centre; and enhancing and protecting the environmental design quality of the Town Centre. The area covered by the AAP extends across Camberley Town Centre.

The Camberley Town Centre AAP Preferred Options Paper sets out the Council's preferred approach to addressing the future of Camberley Town Centre and is accompanied by a Sustainability Appraisal/Strategic Environment Assessment (SA/SEA) Report.
