Housing Needs Development Plan Document Preferred Options for the Surrey Heath Local Development Framework

The Housing Needs Development Plan Document (DPD) will form part of the Local Development Framework for Surrey Heath and will set out policies for addressing housing need up to 2026.

The DPD will address issues such as affordable housing, the size of dwellings, housing for older people and people with disabilities, housing for key workers such as teachers and nurses, and accommodation for Travelling Showpeople, Gypsies and Travellers.

The area covered by the DPD is the whole of the Borough.

The Housing Needs DPD Preferred Options Paper sets out the Council's preferred approach to addressing housing need in the Borough and is accompanied by a Sustainability Appraisal/Strategic Environment Assessment (SA/SEA) Report.
