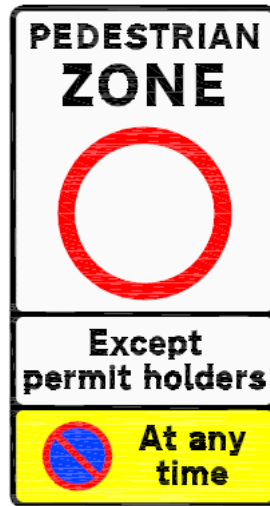

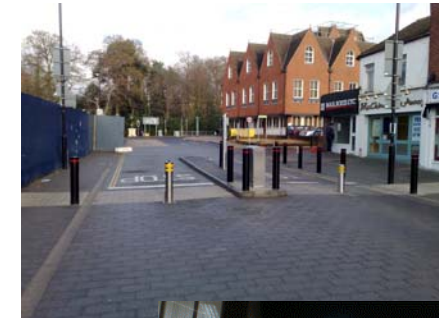

Park Street Camberley Pedestrian Zone

A guide for local businesses



The Park Street pedestrian zone was created in June 2008 and includes:

- Park Street, between Service Area 1 and Princess Way
- St Mary's Road
- Service Area 3
- Service Area 5

A rising bollard controls vehicle entry into the pedestrian zone. Most vehicles will request entry via an intercom. Entry permits and proximity cards are also available.

The rising bollard is monitored by CCTV 24 hours a day, with footage stored for enforcement and insurance purposes.

Within the pedestrian zone Park Street is One-Way in a southerly direction.

Vehicles must not park within the pedestrian zone. Any vehicle parked within the zone is liable to be issued with a Penalty Charge Notice.

There are four business-parking places within the pedestrian zone, in Service Area 3. These are only available to premises bordering Service Area 3. Applications should be made to Surrey Heath Borough Council.



The main means of entry into the pedestrian zone is using an intercom link to The Mall security desk.



To use the intercom press 1 and then CALL

Vehicle entry into Park Street is only permitted for certain purposes:

- Deliveries to premises serviced from Park Street, Service Area 3 or Service Area 5 may enter Park Street between midnight and 10.00am, and between 4.00pm and 6.30pm. Delivery drivers should use the intercom to request entry. Any delivery arriving outside these times will be denied entry.
- Customers who need to pick up large or heavy purchased goods from premises serviced from Park Street, Service Area 3 or Service Area 5 may enter Park Street at any time. The retailer should contact The Mall security desk and provide details of the customer's vehicle – the make, model and number plate – and the estimated time of arrival. The customer should then proceed to the rising bollard and use the intercom to request entry.

Vehicles must leave the pedestrian zone as soon as the delivery has been made or the purchased goods collected.

Two types of entry permit are available:

- Type A permits:
A very limited number of premises may apply for a Type A permit to enter Park Street at any time. Type A permits will only be issued to residents, or to gain access to off-street parking, or to gain access to a business-parking place in Service Area 3.
- Type B permits:
Premises serviced from Park Street, Service Area 3 or Service Area 5 may apply for a Type B permit to gain access for delivery vehicles between midnight and 10.00am and between 4.00pm and 6.30pm. Vehicles must leave the pedestrian zone as soon as the delivery has been made.

Applications for permits should be made to Surrey Heath Borough Council. Applicants will need to supply details of the vehicle to which the permit will apply.

Successful applicants will be provided with a proximity card to operate the rising bollard.



All drivers within the pedestrian zone must drive with extreme caution. Pedestrians – especially children – will not expect vehicles to be driving within the zone. Drivers should give way to pedestrians at all times.
