Returns are required by law and must be submitted not later than the end of the third month after the date of the draw.

Any persons who fail to send a return, or who knowingly gives any such return sent to him any information which is false, or who certifies any such return knowing it to contain such false information shall be guilty of an offence

## YOUR LOTTERY MAY BE SUBJECT OF INVESTIGATION FOR

- Making a late return of a statement following lottery held
- Making no returns at all within a year of registration
- Failure to pay the annual fee as it becomes due
- Reports of sales of lottery tickets to persons under the age of sixteen
- Reports of societies running lotteries without holding registration
- Indications that the society has breached permissible limits: and
- Reports of misappropriation of funds.

The following would be likely to affect your status

- Submission of late return (must be submitted no later that three months after the date on which the lottery was held)
- Submission of incomplete or incorrect returns; and breaches of the limits of small society lotteries.
