This booklet provides information regarding the proposals for the unparished areas of Surrey Heath Borough Council. Options are not limited to the proposals set out in this document and you are welcome to propose alternative options.

The current Surrey Heath Borough Council wards that are unparished, that will be discussed in this booklet are:

- Option One: 4 Parish Councils
- Option Two: 2 Parish Councils





- Option Three: I Parish Council
- Option Four: Do nothing

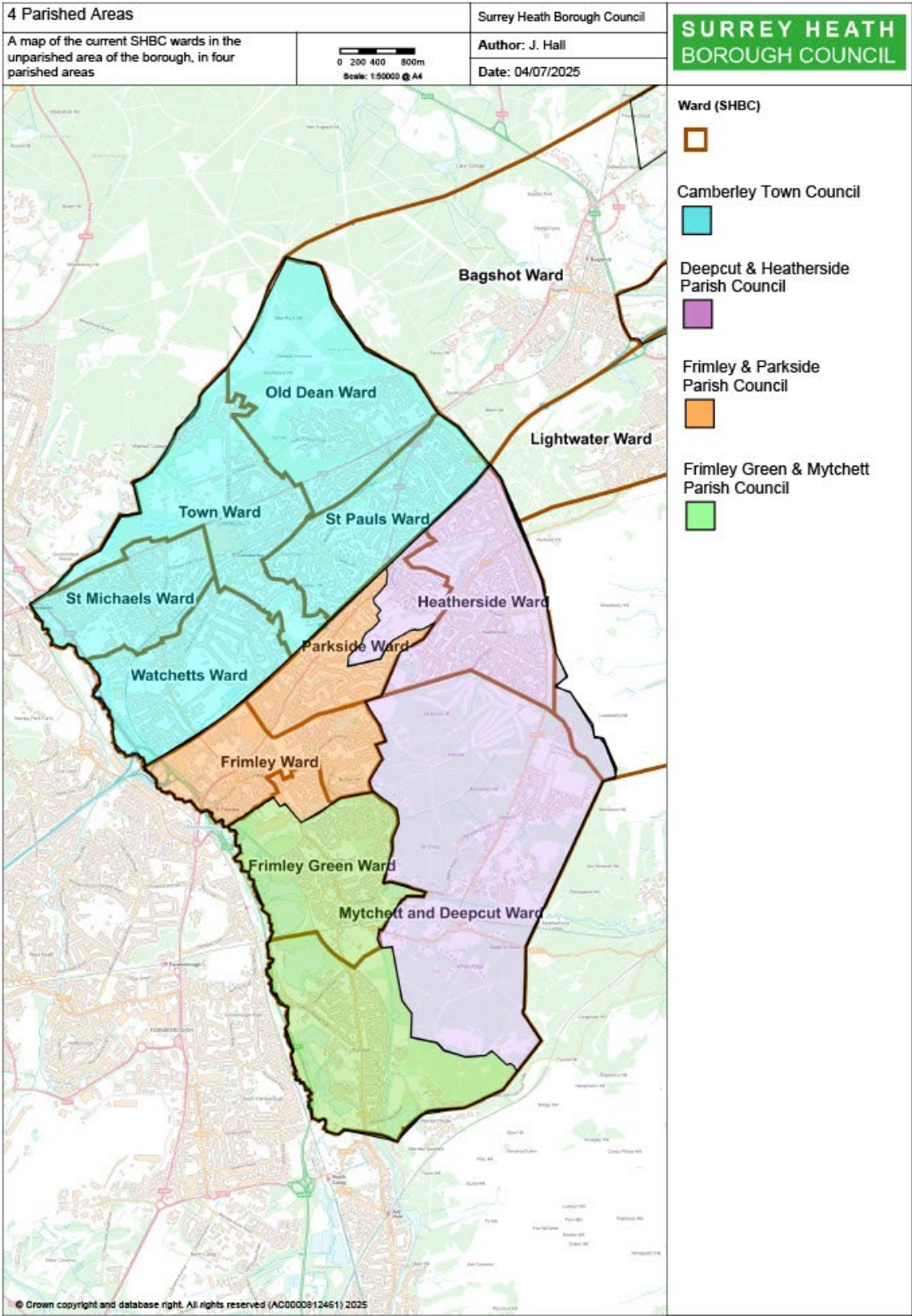


## Option One: 4 Parish Councils

This option would see the creation of four parish councils in the unparished areas of the borough. Each proposed parish is outlined below, detailing the existing Surrey Heath Borough Council (SHBC) wards that would form this parish, the estimated number of electors based on the current register, the projected number of new electors added due to housing development scheduled for the coming five years:

- **Camberley Town Council:**
  - ◆ SHBC wards: Old Dean, St Michaels, St Pauls, Town and Watchetts
  - ◆ Estimate number of electors: 20,533
  - ◆ Projected new electors from developments: 858
  
- **Deepcut & Heatherside Parish Council:**
  - ◆ SHBC Wards: Deepcut, Heatherside and Parkside properties to the east of, and including, Camberley Heath Golf Course
  - ◆ Estimate number of electors: 8,175
  - ◆ Projected new electors from developments: 1,630
  
- **Frimley & Parkside Parish Council:**
  - ◆ SHBC Wards: Frimley, Parkside properties to the west of Camberley Heath Golf Course and Frimley Green properties north of Balmoral Drive
  - ◆ Estimate number of electors: 8,244
  - ◆ Projected new electors from developments: 311
  
- **Frimley Green & Mytchett Parish Council**
  - ◆ SHBC Wards: Mytchett and Frimley Green properties south of Balmoral Drive.
  - ◆ Estimate number of electors: 8,409
  - ◆ Projected new electors from developments: 301





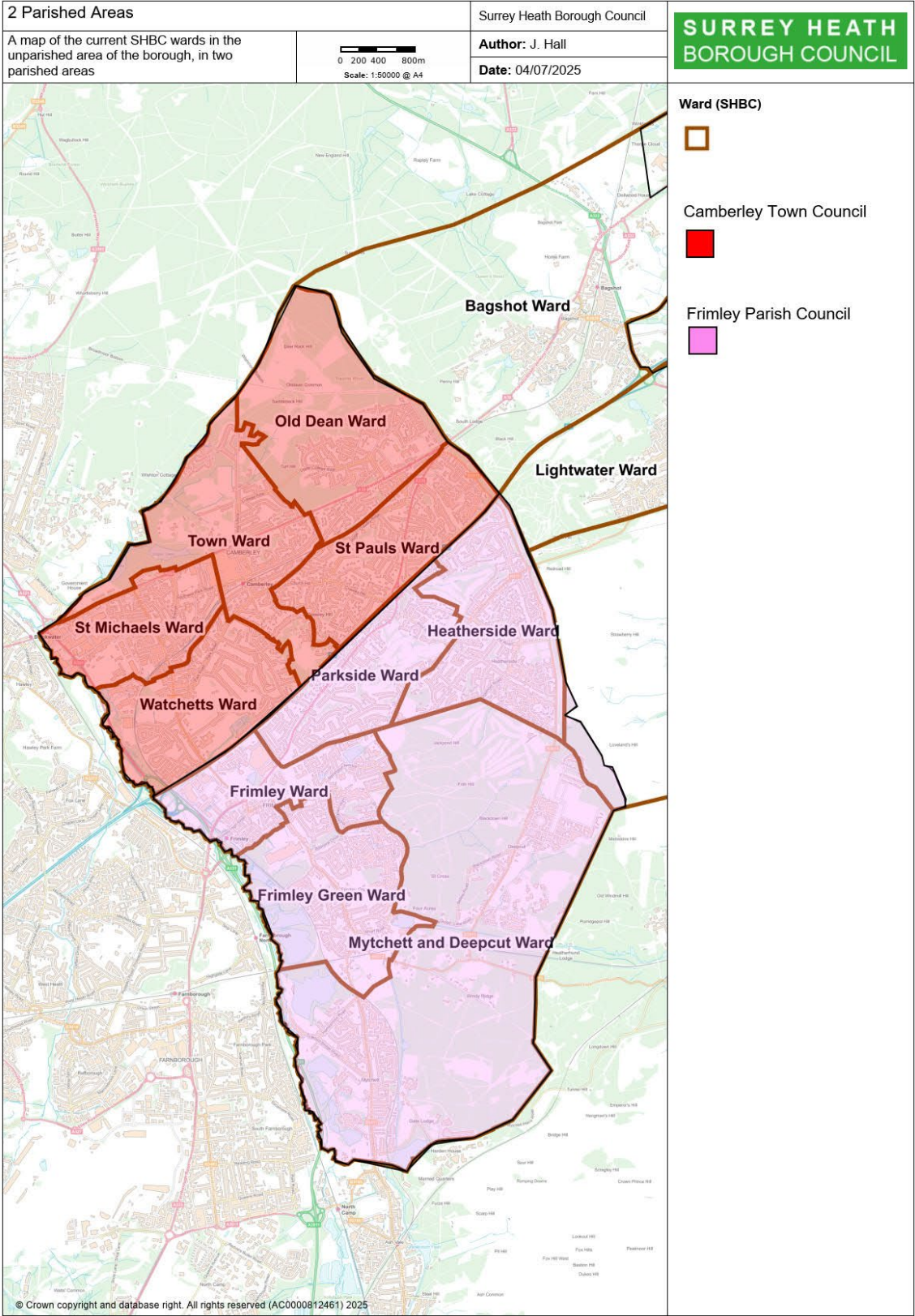
## Option Two: 2 Parish Councils

This option would see the creation of two parish councils in the unparished areas of the borough. Each proposed parish is outlined below, detailing the existing Surrey Heath Borough Council (SHBC) wards that would form this parish, the estimated number of electors based on the current register, the projected number of new electors added due to housing development scheduled for the coming five years:

- Camberley Town Council:
  - ◆ SHBC wards: Old Dean, St Michaels, St Pauls, Town and Watchetts
  - ◆ Estimate number of electors: 20,533
  - ◆ Projected new electors from developments: 858
  
- Frimley Parish Council:
  - ◆ SHBC Wards: Deepcut, Frimley, Frimley Green, Heatherside, Mytchett and Parkside
  - ◆ Estimate number of electors: 24,828
  - ◆ Projected new electors from developments: 2,250







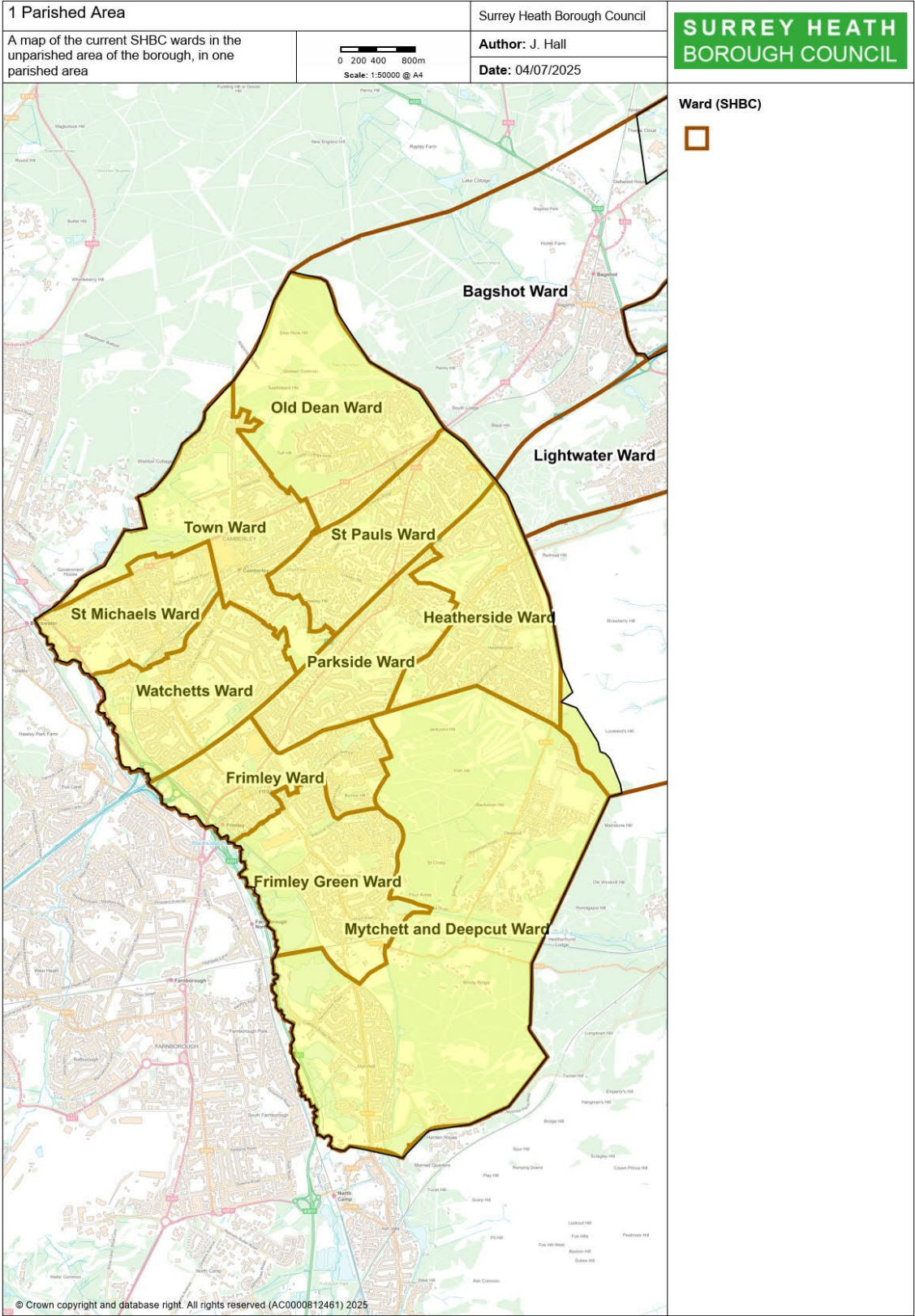
## Option Three: 1 Parish Council

This option would see the creation of two parish councils in the unparished areas of the borough:

- Camberley and Frimley Community Parish Council:
  - ◆ SHBC Wards: Deepcut, Frimley, Frimley Green, Heatherside, Mytchett, Old Dean, Parkside, St Michaels, St Pauls, Town and Watchetts
  - ◆ Estimate number of electors: 45,361
  - ◆ Projected new electors from developments: 3,108

### Projected Elector Numbers

The tables below outline how many electors and households currently sit within each of the boundaries of the parishes within each proposal.

These numbers were taken from the Electoral Register as of 21 May 2025 and are for guidance purposes only.

## Projected Future Elector Numbers

Future developments should be considered when determining where new parished areas are being determined.

The tables below outline how many new housing units are projected for development in the next five years. The tables below outline the projected number of new electors this would create within the newly proposed parishes.

A ratio of 1.8 electors per unit has been taken to calculate the projected electors figure.
