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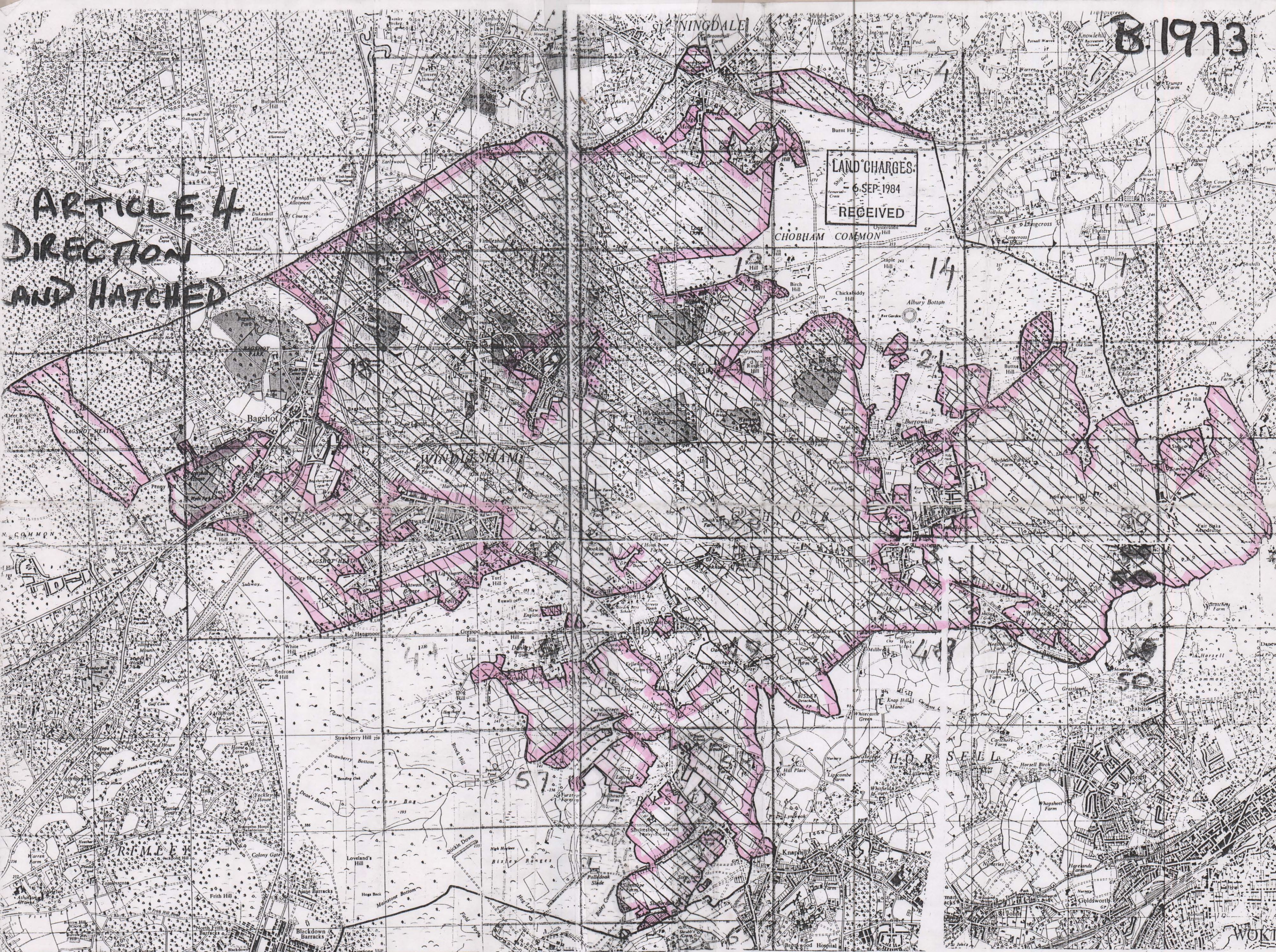

WHEREAS by an Agreement made the 13th day of July, 1948, between the County Council of the Administrative County of Surrey of the one part and the Rural District Council of Bagshot in the said County of Surrey of the other part and made by virtue of Section 34 of the Town & Country Planning Act, 1947, and the Town & Country Planning (Authorisation of Delegation) Regulations, 1947, made in pursuance of that Section, the said County Council delegated to the said Rural District Council the functions of the Local Planning Authority referred to in Part III of the Town & Country Planning Act, 1947, so far as regards the Rural District of Bagshot

AND WHEREAS the Local Planning Authority is satisfied that it is expedient that certain development specified in Class IV of the First Schedule to the Town & Country Planning General Development Order, 1950, should not be carried out in part of the Rural District of Bagshot unless permission is granted on an application in that behalf

NOW THEREFORE the Rural District Council of Bagshot acting on behalf of the County Council of the Administrative County of Surrey HEREBY DIRECTS that the permission granted by Article 3 of the Town & Country Planning General Development Order, 1950, shall not apply to ~~the~~ development in that part of the Rural District of Bagshot referred to in the First Schedule hereto of the description set out in the second Schedule hereto.

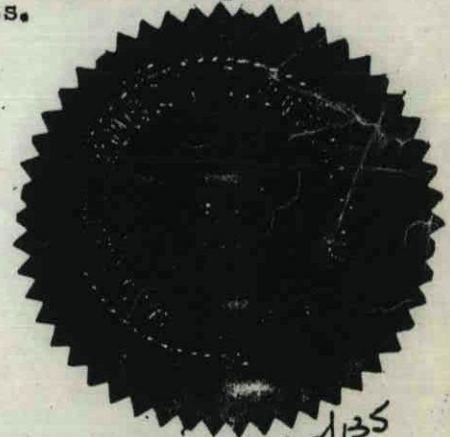

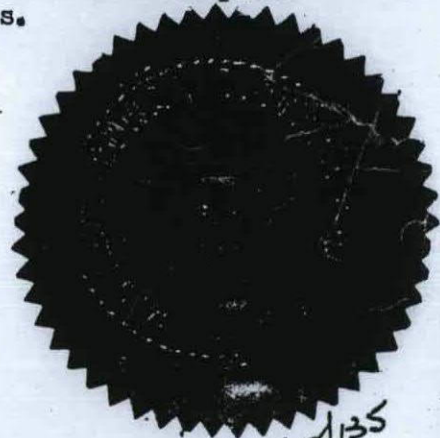
