Land known as the Poors Allotments Staple Hill Road Chobham in the County of Surrey

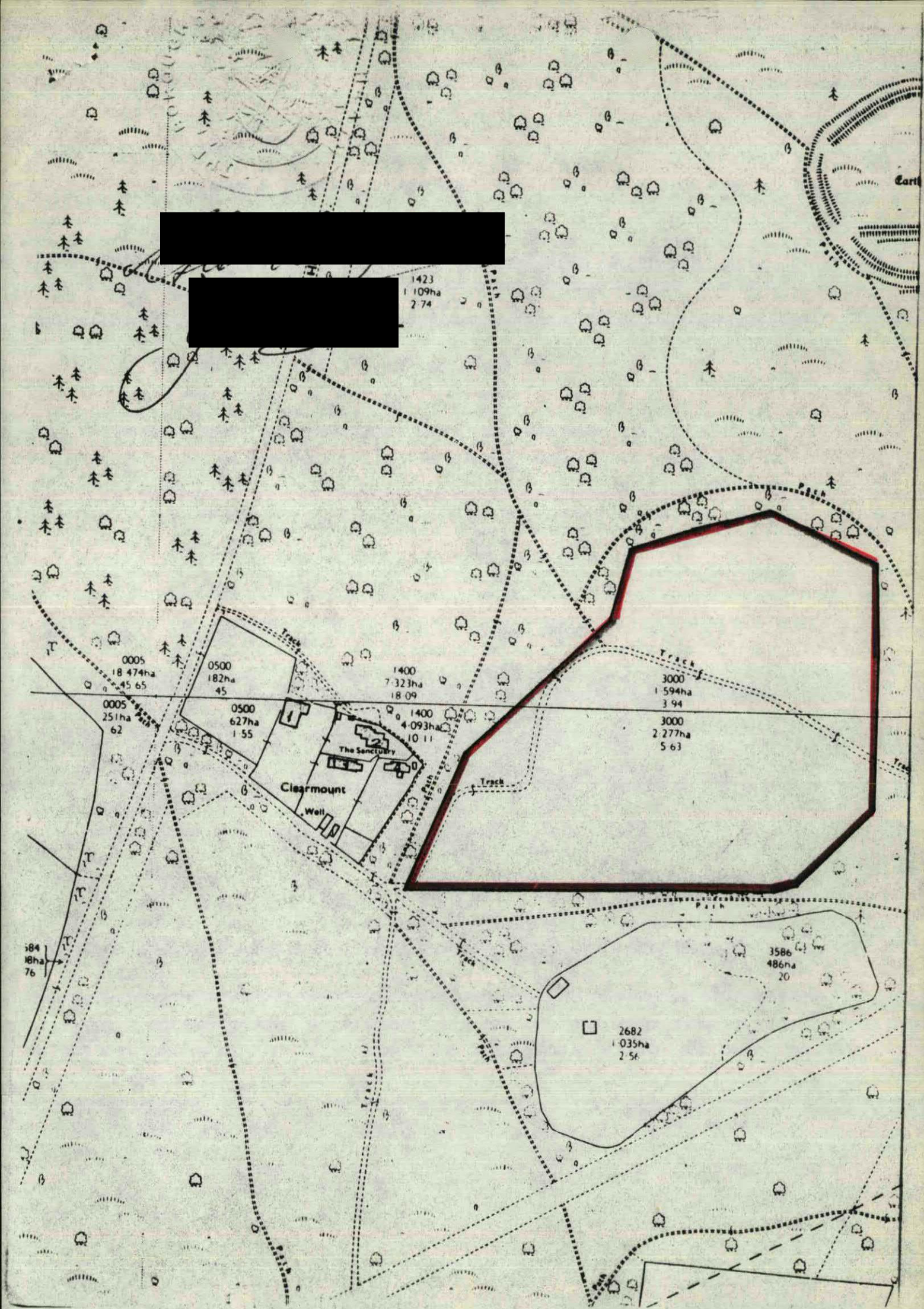
I HEREBY GIVE YOU NOTICE (as owner occupier person interested in) that the SURREY HEATH BOROUGH COUNCIL have made a Direction under Article 4 of the above mentioned Order relating to the land known as the Poors Allotments Staple Hill Road Chobham with respect to development described in Class IV of the First Schedule of the above mentioned Order

The effect of the Direction is that the permission granted under Article 3 of the above mentioned Order shall not apply to development within the said Class IV and described therein as follows:-

The use of land (other than a building on the curtilage of a building) for any purpose or purposes except as a caravan site on not more than 28 days in total in any calendar year (of which not more than 14 days in total may be devoted to use for the purpose of motor car or motor cycle racing or the purpose of the holding of markets) and the erection or placing of moveable structures on the land for the purposes of that use; and the said development shall not be carried out on the said land unless permission is granted by the local Planning Authority on an application made in that behalf

A copy of the direction and of the map defining the area of land to which the Direction relates may be seen at the offices of the said Council at Bagshot Manor Green Lane Bagshot and London Road Camberley between 9 a m and 5 p m

A copy of the Direction has been submitted to the Secretary of State at the Department of the Environment in accordance with Article 4 (4) of the above mentioned Order. The said direction will come into force on the date of service of this Notice upon the owner of the land the subject of the above direction and shall remain in force ^{for} ~~from~~ six months from the date on which it was made and shall then expire unless it has within the six months been approved by the Secretary of State such approval having been specifically requested
