Surrey Heath Borough Council has prepared an Infrastructure Delivery Supplementary Planning Document (SPD) which was adopted on 22<sup>nd</sup> July 2014 by the Council's Executive. The Infrastructure Delivery Supplementary Planning Document (SPD) will address the implementation of the Community Infrastructure Levy (CIL) and the Borough Councils approach to Section 106 (S106) developer contributions. The SPD places particular emphasis on directing monies collected towards infrastructure and avoidance measures required by European Legislation i.e. Suitable Alternative Natural Greenspace (SANG) as a priority.
